On Friday morning, March 16, at 6:30 am the Landisville Quiz team joined 360 other quizzers, coaches and staff at Dutch Wonderland. We boarded one of the seven Elite Coach buses traveling to Northeast Ohio for the final event of the year - the Invitational Tournament. There we joined another 20 teams from Ohio and Virginia.

During the day Saturday, there were a total of 264 matches, with 13 individual matches running simultaneously every 20 minutes at Archbold High School. Today we are gathered in the gym for a time of worship followed by the semi-final and final quiz matches. At 11 am we board the buses for the return trip to Lancaster.

York Detention Center detainee visitation/departure assistance plan

PIRC has been in touch with officials at the center to try to set up a meeting to discuss whether or not cooperation between the local community and detention staff could lead to a plan that would allow visits with detainees as well as help for those who are released and don't know where to go or how to get there.
