Sunday morning nursery and preschool activities

Today marks a transitional time in our children's Sunday school calendar as well as our nursery and preschool activity schedules. Preschool worship and preschool activity bags (1st Sunday of the month) are for 2 year olds up until the start of kindergarten. Children ages 0-2 are welcome in the nursery during the worship and Sunday school hour. When a child turns 2 years old he/she is invited to participate in Preschool Worship (room 10) when ready to interact with older children in structured activities. If a child attends Preschool Worship but wasn't old enough for Sunday school at the start of a new school year, his/her parents can escort their child from Preschool Worship to the nursery after the service.

A Sunday school class is offered for children who are 2 years old at the start of a new school year. The 2 and 3 year old classroom is located in room 10.
