Walking Together Detainee Visitation Program

In October of 2018 a group of individuals from our church, and many from beyond, began weekly visits to immigration detainees held at the York County Prison in York, PA. In March of 2020 the program came to a screeching halt due to the Covid-19 pandemic. An email response from the prison warden had lately indicated an openness to resuming the program. In the meantime, the contract that the prison held with Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) was not renewed and all detainees were scheduled to have been either released or moved to other facilities by mid-August 2021. We wish to thank our church family for the support we felt for the effort. Those who visited connected deeply with many of the detainees they spent ½ hour visiting, on telephones that sometimes worked well and sometime didn't, through the solid plexi-glass between them. The visitation program is over, at least for now. However, the need to advocate for our neighbors to the south is more needed than ever. May we continue to do so as we find opportunity to do so.
